We offer information to assist health care professionals with specific patients being treated for peripartum mental health issues, including detailed information about effects of antidepressant medications during pregnancy and breastfeeding. We also offer screening and assessment tools, on-site assistance for implementing screening & assessment procedures, and training workshops. Lastly, we can answer questions about anxiety disorders, dyadic and family interventions, and the impact of perinatal mental health issues on the mother-infant relationship. Our expertise over the perinatal period covers many different aspects, so please feel free to ask any question you may have.
